## Online MSc in Occupational Health

An integrated course in Occupational Health, Safety and Welfare

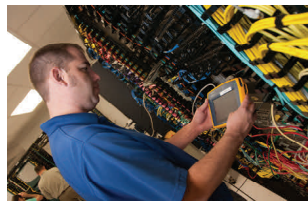


Do you want a qualification in Occupational Health and Safety while studying with time flexibility and in the comfort of your home?

This might be the course for you!

The course is suitable for individuals already **working in occupational safety and health**, or for those with a strong interest in this area and who wish to **build a new career in this field**.

The online MSc in Occupational Health is a course with an international multidisciplinary perspective of occupational health & safety incorporating public health, health promotion, occupational medicine & hygiene, psychology, law, risk assessment & management, training & development, ergonomics and epidemiology.



This Masters course will help you make a difference in the prevention of occupational injury and disease.

The core modules for this course are:

- Research Methods and Information Retrieval in Occupational Health
- Psychosocial Epidemiology
- Occupational Health & Safety Management
- Critical Appraisal of Publications
- Legal Aspects of Occupational Safety & Health
- Applied Research Methods for Occupational Health
- Risk Assessment & Management Programmes in the Workplace
- Workplace Health, Safety & Wellbeing Dissertation

**Elective modules include:** Psychology Applied to Occupational Health & Safety; Global & Environmental Health; Principles & Practice of Health Protection; Tobacco Control: National & International Approaches, Training & Development Issues in Occupational Health.



This **18 months** part-time course will be delivered through **interactive online sessions** and webinars, which may require a **minimum of 10 hours of weekly engagement** from the student.

The interactive format of the sessions encourages national and international **student networking** and the **sharing of knowledge and practical experience**. Through the several modules students will work with practical case studies, engage in project work and reflective inquiry.

A unique course offering you the opportunity to study and undertake cutting-edge research on causation, prevention & management of work-related accidents, injury and disease.



With this course you will be able to:

- Practice measures to prevent disease & injury, protect and promote health & safety in occupational settings;
- Perform workplace risk assessments including psychosocial risk factors;
- Identify the role of psychology in improving the quality of work life;
- Apply research evidence to occupational health & safety interventions and health promotion strategies by taking relevant legislation into account;
- Design occupational health training and development programmes in line with organisational policy;
- Carry out a focused piece of scholarly research and develop a health & safety programme evaluation;
- Professionally communicate and appreciate the benefits of life-long learning.

Candidates should meet **one of the following** requirements:

1. An honours primary degree in a cognate area or equivalent and relevant professional experience
- OR
2. A minimum of a Diploma in Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare or equivalent qualification (minimum second class honours grade I) and a relevant professional qualification as well as relevant work experience .

Course fees:

EU students - Yearly fee of €2,925 (for 45 credit). Total fee for the online MSc Occupational Health (90 credits) of €5,850.

Non-EU students - Yearly €4,000 (for 45 credit). Total fee for the online MSc Occupational Health (90 credits) of €8,000.
